

NOTICE OF PROPOSED TAX INCREASE

The following taxing entities within WEBER COUNTY are proposing to increase property tax revenue in 2026. Data shown below is based on the taxing entity's average value. The same value is used for both residential and commercial property. Concerned citizens are invited to attend the public hearings listed below, in person or online, which are being held for the purpose of hearing comments regarding the proposed tax increase and for the entity to explain the reasons for the proposed increase.

If the proposed budget is approved, WEBER FIRE DISTRICT would receive an additional \$2,956,000 in property tax revenue per year. This would be an increase of approximately 23.58% above this year's property tax budgeted revenue excluding eligible new growth.

If the proposed budget is approved, WEBER AREA DISPATCH 911 AND EMERGENCY SERVICES DISTRICT would receive an additional \$275,000 in property tax revenue per year. This would be an increase of approximately 4.87% above this year's property tax budgeted revenue excluding eligible new growth.
