Subject: Open Burning and Agriculture Burning



The Weber Fire District wants to remind the citizens of Farr West, Marriott- Slaterville, West Haven, Hooper, Huntsville, Uintah, Ogden Valley Cities, and Unincorporated Weber County, the open burn window for yard cleanup starts March 30 through May 30, 2026. You can obtain a burn permit by visiting the Department of Air Quality (DAQ) website at www.airquality.utah.gov or visiting the Weber Fire District website at www.weberfiredistrict.com for further information.

Burn Permit Guideline:

- 1- A burn permit must be obtained using the on-line process and approved. The clearing index must be above 500ft to burn legally.
- 2- The burning material must be of vegetation type example (tree limbs, leaves, and grass clippings)
- 3- Tires, trash, paint, conventional lumber, or any material that is manufactured is **NOT** allowed to be burned.
- 4- Fire must be always accompanied at all times and shall be out before dark.
- 5- Agricultural burns: Does not need to obtain a burn permit From October 31 through May 30. If burning of **“Ditch Banks, Fence Lines, Stubble (Grain, Corn), Open lands or Grazing lands”**. Agriculture Burns during the closed fire season from June 1 through October 31 **Shall Obtain a Burn Permit**. using the on-line burn permit process. Agriculture burns can burn below 500 ft clearing index.
- 6- The Fire Department does reserve the right to extinguish any fire that becomes a public nuisance or becomes out of control.
- 7- Failure to comply with State or County open burning regulations could result in a citation
