Hooper City has adopted the full State of Utah Executive Order banning fireworks in the boundaries of the city through July 5, 2026. Utah Code § 15A-5-202.5(1)(b)

Hooper City is a rural community, with farm ground surrounding almost every subdivision. The city parks are dry because of the lack of water this year. Within the city are barns full of hay and straw. Residential lawns are struggling to stay green with the watering constraints. Dry grass can be seen along the roadways, ditches, canals, and sloughs. Because of all these circumstances, I do not feel there is a safe area in Hooper that we could or should designate for fireworks.

I appreciate our residents, and I hope that you will follow this ban. I always want what is best for all of us, and at this time, this is what is best.
